WARNING – SERVICE ON THE LEFT: Riders are reminded ALL service is to be conducted on the right side of the road. Riders who stop on the left must move to the right before receiving service.

FOR STAGE 3:

ANNOUNCEMENT – PRE-RIDING: The time trial course will be available for inspection on Friday morning beginning at 8:30am. Riders and team vehicles must be off the course by 10am.

REMINDER – TIME TRIAL NUMBERS AND EQUIPMENT:

- Courtesy bike pre-check will be available at the Stage 3 start area beginning at 9:30 am.
- All bicycles to be used at the Stage 3 Time Trial must pass a mandatory final bicycle check for compliance with UCI regulations prior to each rider's start. Riders with their bicycles must be present at the start area at least 15 minutes prior to their assigned start time. No starts will be allowed without rider's bicycles passing the mandatory bicycle check, regardless of their start time or when the rider's arrival at the start area.
- Riders are reminded that once a bike has undergone a final measurement for the time trial the bicycle must stay within the start enclosure. Any bicycles removed from the start area prior to the start will be rechecked for compliance.
- Riders must wear at least one number on the center of the back for time trials.

WARNING – CENTER LINE: This is an out and back course. Riders must stay to the right of the centerline at all times. Where a painted median exists with two sets of double yellow lines, riders must stay to the right of the right-most set of lines.
