

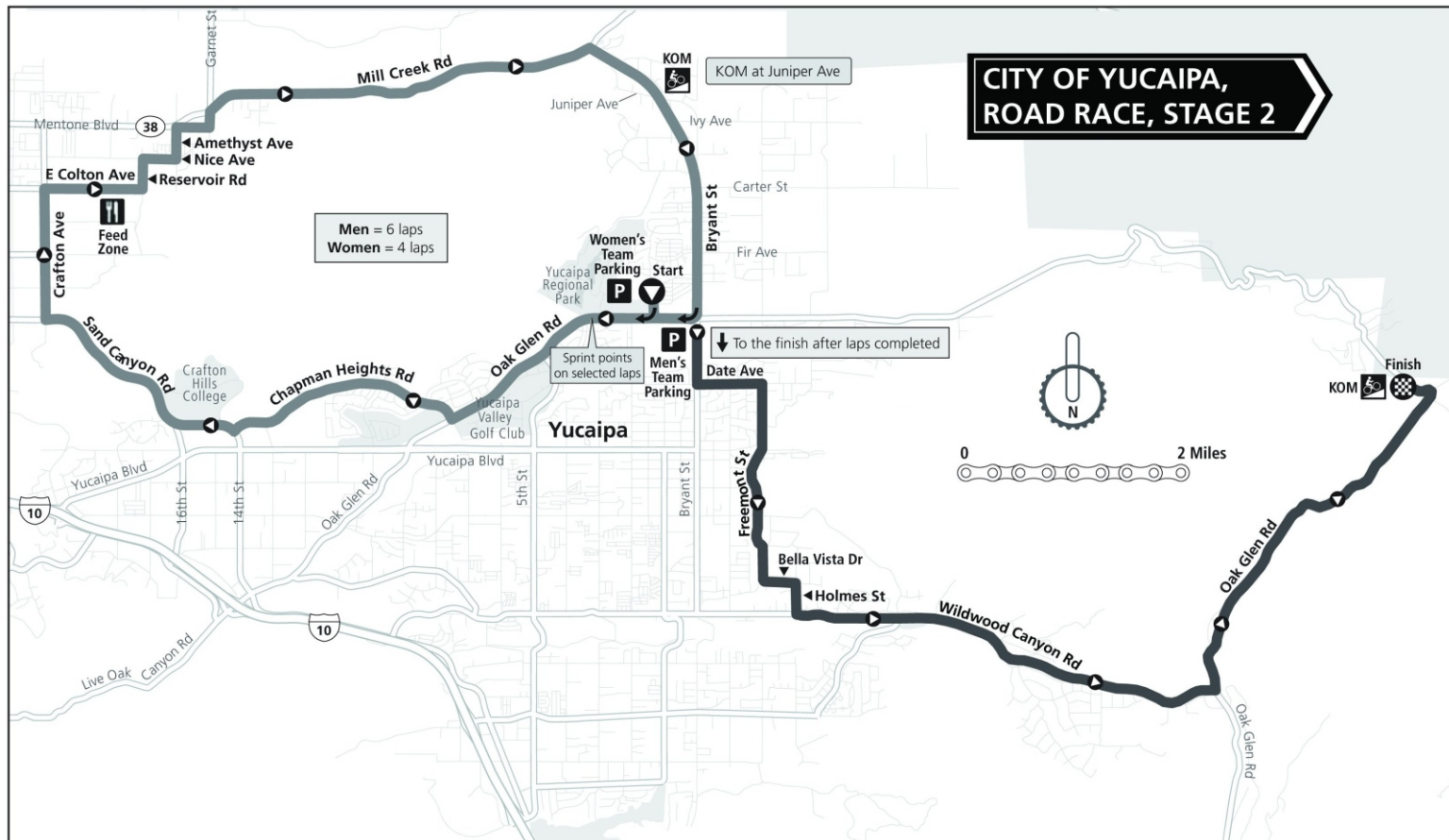

Dear Yucaipa Neighbor:

The 2017 Redlands Bicycle Classic is excited to announce that the Yucaipa Road Race is returning to this year's event on Thursday, May 4, 2017, in the City of Yucaipa and surrounding areas. We would like to thank all of the residents and businesses along the course for their assistance and patience, as we bring you one of the premier cycling events in the country.

The Yucaipa Stage is a "circuit" race, which means the cyclists will be completing numerous laps around the course. This will give you an opportunity to see them up close and cheer them on as they pass by your location. Spectators may walk along the outside of the course, however, please be sure to stay off the course itself. The riders will be exceeding 50 MPH at times, and we want to ensure your safety, as well as the safety of the riders.

With safety as our top primary concern, there will be some local street closures in place throughout the day:

- 8:30 am – 3:00 pm Sunnyside Drive between Oak Glen Road and Tahoe Drive will be closed to through traffic.
- 8:00 am – 3:00 pm Sand Canyon between Chapman Heights Road and Crafton Avenue will be narrowed to one lane of traffic each direction.
- 8:45 am – 10:30 am Para-cycle race will race on a circuit of Sunnyside – Fir – Bryant – Sunnyside – Summerwood – Golden Hills - Tahoe - Sunnyside.
- 9:00 am – 3:00 pm Oak Glen Road from Chapman Heights Road to Bryant Street will be closed to Eastbound traffic. Westbound lanes will remain open to residents only. Crafton Avenue from 5th Street to Citrus Avenue will be closed. All other streets shown as a **heavy line** on the map may experience brief delays.
- 1:00 pm – 3:30 pm Southbound traffic from Los Rios Ranch will be closed.

Traffic will be impacted at several schools in the area. Access to Chapman Heights Elementary School, Ridgeview Elementary School and Park View Middle School may be briefly delayed between 8:30 am and 2:00 pm. Primary access for kindergarten pick up will be from Fir Street to Ridgeview Elementary and from Yucaipa Blvd/Oak Glen Rd/Chapman Heights Rd for Chapman Heights Elementary. As race day approaches, individual schools will provide detailed instructions through recorded messages. Please drive cautiously!

If you anticipate leaving your business or residence during race time, please understand that there may be a delay, as our marshals must wait until there are no cyclists approaching before they allow you on the course. At that time, you will be allowed onto the course, **but only in the direction of the race**, and you will be required to **exit the course at the next opportunity**. Refer to the attached map to determine the direction the race will be traveling. If you are having difficulty getting to a specific location, contact one of our marshals or a law enforcement official. Our marshals will be strategically placed throughout the course to assist you in getting where you need to go. If you need to leave a residence on the course while the race is in progress, it is imperative that you seek assistance from a marshal before exiting. If possible, please park your vehicle on a street off of the course ahead of time.

Finally, loose dogs present a significant hazard to cyclists traveling at high speeds. Please ensure that your pet is secured during the event.
